

KCOC Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

Attention KCOC members who have children or grandchildren graduating from high school this year. Your son, daughter, or grandchildren may be eligible for a KCOC scholarship. The eligibility requirements are as follows:

1. High school graduates of the current school year who are children, grandchildren, or under the legal guardianship of a Kama'aina Club member in good standing for a period of one (1) full year, are eligible. The year of membership shall be one year immediately preceding the deadline on which the applications must be submitted. Associate and honorary members are not eligible.
 2. Eligible graduates who do not apply for the current year will not be eligible to apply the following year.
 3. Applicants who applied previously, but were for any reason denied a scholarship, with the exception of membership requirements are no longer eligible.
 4. At the end of their Junior Year, scholarship applicants must have a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 if applicant intends to study at a 2-year or 4-year college or university, or a minimum GPA of 3.0 for a vocational institution.
 5. Applicant must intend to enroll in a 2-year or 4-year accredited college or a vocational school.
